

# Club Affiliation Manual (2024) – For Clubs Who Affiliated Last Year

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#### Introduction

This manual will explain the steps you will take to affiliate your club to Scottish Cycling for 2023/24. Affiliation will take place via our Club Management System, Servesport, as was the case in 2023. The manual will take you through each stage of the affiliation form, outlining the requirements for each section.

## Minimum Operating Standards

Scottish Cycling has introduced Minimum Operating Standards (MOS) for clubs. The MOS have been introduced to ensure that we can work with clubs to ensure that you have all the correct policies and procedures in place – protecting both you and your members.

We recognise that not all clubs operate in the same way, and cater to different audiences, so we have reflected this in the standards, so that the expectation of what clubs need to do is appropriate to what your club does.

Scottish Cycling is here to support you and your club in meeting these standards.

Whilst many clubs are already operating at or close to these standards, they provide a helpful checklist to ensure that members, clubs and Scottish Cycling have confidence that the minimum standards are being consistently met across the sport in Scotland. For some this will represent a mere formalisation of existing processes and standards. For others that do not yet meet these standards, Scottish Cycling will actively support you in putting the standards in place.

We want to make it as easy as possible for clubs to meet the standards, so we have provided a range of templates and guides for each standard so that clubs have all the resources required.



## Training Venues/Meet-Up Points



- Provide the full address and postcode of each of your main club training venue(s) and/or meet-up point(s). You can add up to three main club training venues.
- This should include meet-up points in parks or car parks that your club may use.
- You will need to select if the training venue/meet-up point is owned by the club, a local authority or other.
- Fill in what disciplines you cater for and what age groups you have.
- Click 'next'.







- If your club has a WPO, tick the box and please fill in their details.
- We require all clubs to have Codes of Conduct in place (if these audiences exist within your club).





## Fees Payable



- This section will outline the fees payable by your club in order to affiliate to Scottish Cycling for the year 2023.
- Clubs will receive a discount for 'early-bird' renewal. This discount is £25 for a standard club
  and £50 for a commercial club if your club submits the affiliation form before 11<sup>th</sup> December
  2022.
- If your club has any sponsors, tick the box and enter these details (see 11b). Sponsors are £68 each for the first 4 and free thereafter.
- If you are a youth club you do not pay for sponsors.
- Click 'Proceed to Payment.


